Call for applications for the Winter School in Cultural Heritage in the Near and Middle East

Art. 1 - Procedure for submitting an application for admission

In order to register for the Course, candidates must observe the following procedures

1 - Register with the University's information system (Infostud) by accessing the University's website <https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina-strutturale/studenti> at the end of the registration, the system will issue a serial number and a password to access the Infostud system. The serial number must be included in the application for admission to the Advanced Training Course.

ATTENTION: it is important to enter a valid email address in the contact details, because the password recovery procedure is done by email. If the candidate has already been a student at Sapienza, she\he does not have to register, since she\he already has a serial number. If you do not remember the student's ID or password, you can follow the automatic procedure of recovery of the Infostud system.

2 - Fill in the application form for admission to the Course, on plain paper, using the form attached to this announcement (Annex 1). The application for admission must be accompanied by an obligatory form: - Photocopy of a valid identity document, duly signed and legible (Identity Card / Driver's License / Passport); - Self-certification of the university degree obtained;

APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION OF CANDIDATES WITH ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS OBTAINED ABROAD

In addition to submitting the application for admission in accordance with the procedures described, candidates holding an academic qualification obtained abroad must submit by the same deadline of 15/01/2019 the following documents:

For candidates with a qualification obtained in a country of the European Union: self-certification, pursuant to Articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions, of the degree with list of exams and related votes in Italian or English. For candidates with a qualification obtained in a country NOT belonging to the European Union: degree certification with list of exams and related votes translated and legalized in Italian or English.

- Declaration of consent for the processing of personal data (Annex 2);

The application for admission, signed by the candidate and accompanied by the annexes, must be received by and no later than 15/01/2019 according to the following procedures:

Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

Art. 2 - Ranking of admissions

The course secretariat verifies the admission requirements and publishes a list of participants in the course by 20/01/2019.

After the publication of the ranking, it is possible to enrol in the course through the Infostud system and pay the enrolment fee.

Art. 3 - Enrolment fee for the Advanced Training/Training/Tensile Courses (Summer and Winter school) course

The Enrolment fee is of € 500 (250 students Sapienza) to be paid in accordance with the procedures of Articles. 5 and 6 no later than 30/01/2019.

Students with recognized disability equal to or greater than 66% or with recognition of disability pursuant to art. 3, paragraphs 1 and 3, of Law No. 104 of 5 February 1992, are exempt from 50% of the registration fee.

The enrolment fee will be refunded only and exclusively if the course is not activated. In this case the student, in order to obtain the reimbursement, must submit an application to the Director of the Course.

Art. 4 - Duration and organization of training activities

The Winter School lasts two weeks, lessons will begin on December 29, 2019 and will end on February 9, 2020. The training activity is equal to 80 hours of total commitment, of which at least 68 hours are dedicated to frontal teaching activities.

The attendance of 75% of the activities provided by the Course entitles the student to the certificate of attendance and allows the possible recognition of 12 CFUs. The CFU acquired in the Training Courses or in the Intensive Courses (Summer/Winter School) can be recognized by BA/MA courses up to a maximum of 12 Cfu, as long as they are consistent with the contents of the course itself. In the event of failure to attend, or

other censurable conduct, the Director may decide not to issue the certificate of attendance of the course. In this case the registration fees paid will not be refunded.

Art. 5 - Methods of payment of the enrolment fee for the Winter School.

The student admitted to the course must access Infostud2.0 from the page <https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina-strutturale/studenti> with registration number and password, click on the box "TRAINING COURSES", then click on "TAXES - REGISTRATION", enter the code of the course indicated on the announcement and follow the instructions below. The payment of the enrolment fee must be made within the deadline provided for in this announcement (see point 3), through the bulletin downloaded from Infostud in the manner illustrated on the web page of the Sapienza institutional website: <https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/come-pagare> or through the PagoPA payment service.

Full professors of educational institutions of all levels can pay up to € 500.00 by using the so-called "Teacher's Charter". In this case, after the deadline indicated in art. 1, the participant admitted to the course must write to the e-mail address altaformazione@uniroma1.it attaching the bonus generated by the MIUR website to receive, again by e-mail, a bulletin to pay the difference, if due, between the course registration fee and the amount of the bonus. The registration fee cannot be refunded in any way. The student can apply for a refund only if the course is not activated.

Art. 6 - Methods of payment of course enrolment fees by an Institution/Company

If there are more than one beneficiary, change the total amount of the transfer and the reason for it accordingly with the indication of the serial numbers of all the beneficiaries.

2 - after making the transfer, send an e-mail with your references (company name, VAT number / tax code, contact details, first name and last name and serial number of the beneficiary / beneficiaries) to francesca.bernabei@uniroma1.it, once the payment is verified, the offices of the Accounting Department of the University will issue a receipt for the amount paid, and send it to the address indicated in the application form.
